In zones where there is no grade 9 league, teams may participate in junior leagues and remain eligible for the BC Grade 9 Tournament, provided the team declares to their junior zone representative that they will not be attending the junior provincial tournament should they qualify. Home wears light jersey and away wears dark jersey.

4. **Seeds – 2009** – Seeding will be done by committee based upon strength of areas, season records, and opinions from coaches. No team from a region shall be seeded higher than a team from the same region based upon order of finish in their respective playoffs. In addition, first round match-ups will not include games between teams from the same zone. This is at the request of coaches at our annual meeting. The Seeding committee will send me the seed chart as shown below once all zone playoffs have concluded.

5. **Tournament Draw**

Once we know the results from all the zone playoff games, a draw that takes into consideration the travel needs of out of town teams and first and second round match-ups will be created. The draw will be e-mailed to all coaches on or before Wednesday, F. Note that the draw is separate from the seeding. The travel needs of teams and first round matchups may affect a team's first game.
