



SENIOR BASKETBALL

FV COMMISSION LEAGUE RESPONSIBILITIES

The Fraser Valley Basketball Commission is responsible for the organization and maintenance of all Senior Boys and Girls Leagues. The Commission handles this responsibility by:

1. geographically organizing all Senior Leagues. If this is done by the League itself, Commission approval must be granted.
2. working with a league coordinator as selected by the League.
3. setting the date for League Play to finish.
4. setting any other guidelines for Senior Leagues as the members of the FV or the Executive may deem necessary.
5. acting as an appeal or arbitrator on any League matter that may include discipline, seeding or otherwise.

LEAGUE RESPONSIBILITIES

The FV leagues, through their league coordinators, are responsible for:

1. the election and renewal of league coordinators.
2. regular league meetings where the principles of democracy determine league policy.
3. publishing a league as scheduled (based on the principles agreed to by the members).
4. furnishing the FV Commission with FV qualifying teams through league play or league playoff tournament play.
5. coordinating of the collection of Team Photos and Lineups.
6. representing League affairs at the meetings of the FV Commission Executive.

Leagues are permitted to create their own schedule guidelines and do other functions not specified by the Commission including awards and all-star games. However, all leagues must abide by all rules, guidelines and motions passed by the Fraser Valley Basketball Commission. It is expected that all Leagues will take an active part in hosting and maintaining strong FV Championships.

FV COMMISSION ZONE CHAMPIONSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

The FV Commission is responsible for all FV tournaments. It is responsible for:

In some cases, the FV Championship Tourney is run by the League Coordinator or a member of the League. This is the case with Senior A & AA Boys and Girls.

In other cases, the FV Championship Tourney is operated by an appointed group:
AAA Girls - the Vice President for Girls is responsible for this appointment.
AAA Boys - the Vice President for Boys, and the President, are responsible for this appointment.

Because of the great financial nature of the AAA Tournaments, the whole Basketball Commission votes on the selection of the site for the tournament.

PHOTOS AND LINE-UPS

The deadline for league photos and line-ups is the first school Friday in January - **January 8, 2010**. The coach of each Senior Boys and Senior Girls team will deliver or email their photo and lineup to the Executive Secretary, Jodi De Julius by January 9, 2009.

Teams that do not submit their photo and line-up by the deadline will be assessed an escalating fine for each week that the photo and line-up is late. The fines will be applied as follows:

- After **January 8** - \$50.00 And must accompany photo and line-up.
- After **January 15** - \$75.00 And must accompany photo and line-up.
- After **January 22** - \$100.00 And must accompany photo and line-up.

After January 8th the Treasurer will deduct the fine amounts from individual school Performance Bond accounts that have not met their commitments as listed above.

A team who hands in its photo and line-up but does not pay its fine is suspended until the fine is paid. The league commissioners will be responsible to notify school of their suspensions.

In December, our league Executive Secretary will notify each school's basketball contact with a notice of the requirement to submit their schools Senior Boys and Senior Girls team photo and line-up. The notification will include a copy of the approved team line-up form

along with this section of the handbook as information.

PHOTOS-

All Players **must** be in uniform. All player numbers **must** be visible.

Coaches need to dress up and be presentable.

All the uniforms must be the same colour. (White looks best).

The team photo must be taken in straight lines of either two or three lines.

NO casual or stunt photos please.

If you change uniforms or add players, you should update your photo and roster.

All text material should be sent as a **MSWord** or **Adobe pdf** document and photos sent as **jpeg** image.

DO NOT use ClarisWorks, AppleWorks, or Word Perfect as these applications cannot be opened on Jodi's PC. Do not embed your photo and/or your roster in your email document; **please send it as an attachment** to your message.
